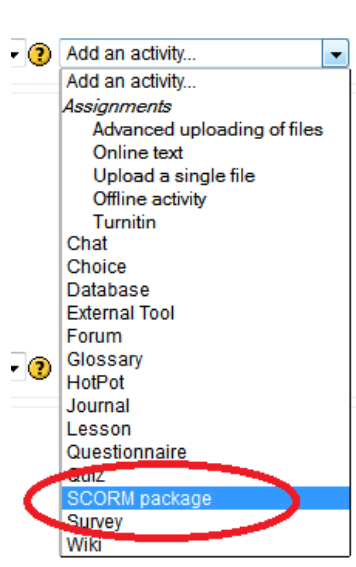


Instructions for Adding a SCORM Tutorial to Moodle

SCORM (Sharable Content Object Reference Model) is a collection of specifications that enable interoperability, accessibility and reusability of web-based learning content, such as eLearning tutorials. The SCORM module in Moodle enables lecturers to upload any SCORM package to include in your course. Moodle supports SCORM version 1.2.

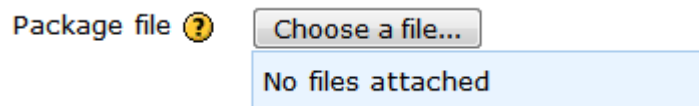
To add the Library SCORM tutorials to your Moodle course, you will first need the SCORM versions of the tutorials. They are .zip files. They can be downloaded from the Library website here: <http://millennium.it-tallaght.ie/screens/downloads.html>
Alternatively, send a request to CeLT (celt@ittdublin.ie) or the Library (library@ittdublin.ie) and they will send the files along to you.

1. To begin, log in to Moodle and go to the course page where you want to add the tutorial.
2. When you go to your Moodle course page, turn editing on.
Note that you must have editing permissions on the course page in order to be able to upload the tutorial files. If you cannot see the **Turn editing on** button this means that you don't have editing permissions. For more information, contact CeLT (celt@ittdublin.ie).
3. From the **Add an activity** dropdown list, select **SCORM package**:

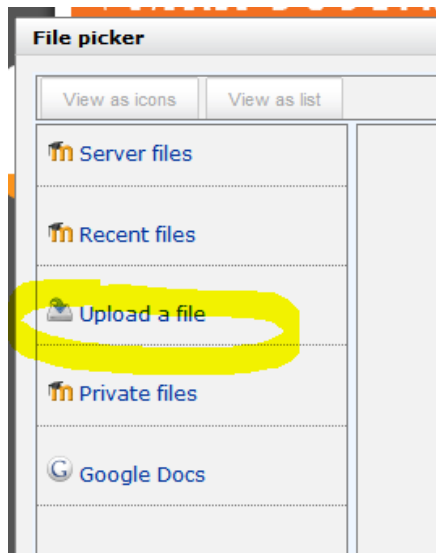


4. Type a name for the tutorial (e.g. 'How to Reference your Sources').
5. Type a short summary for the tutorial. This will give students an indication of what the summary tutorial is about (e.g. In this tutorial you will learn...'). Choose whether you wish to display the summary on the course page.

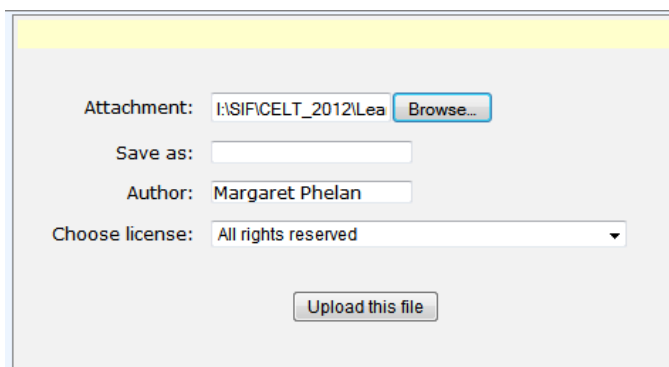
6. In the **Package file** field click **Choose a file**:



7. Select **Upload a file**:



8. Click **Browse** to navigate to where you have saved the SCORM tutorial (Zip file) and click **Open**:



9. Click **Upload this file**.
10. Click **Choose** to select the zip file.
11. Change the other SCORM settings, as follows:
- **Display package**: New window
 - **Width**: 100%
 - **Stage height**: 650

- **Allow the window to be resized:** Yes
- **Allow the window to be scrolled:** Yes
- **Disable preview mode:** Yes
- **Student skip content structure page:** Always
- **Grading method:** Highest
- **Number of attempts:** [To be decided by lecturer]
- Leave other values as default values.

Click **Save and return to course**.

Your tutorial is now ready to be launched by students. Students' scores can be tracked in the Moodle Gradebook.
